We are looking for 2 **members** of the Conference Committee!

About a year or so ago EAGT membership voted to establish a conference committee for the first time since it was formed, 40 years ago.

The committee has 2 vacancies for 2 new members. The committee started as a working group in Berlin, 2023. The first elections took place during the General Meeting of Members in March 2024. The committee has 2 vacancies for 2 new members, it will be voted on at the GMM, October 22nd 2026.

The vacancies concern a voluntary job.

The Conference Committee consists of 5 members, the Chair and 4 officers. Currently the President and the treasurer of EAGT sit on the committee as advised by the bylaws.

The Conference Committee has the major objectives to work towards co-owning future conferences, while keeping their traditional autonomy in mind. As well as to look at future conferences based on past experiences and members wishes and needs, and the relationship between the local hosting NOGT and EAGT, to eventually actually co-own the conference as an EAGT major activity.

Tasks of the members of the Conference Committee:

- To define the role of the new emerging Conference Committee.
- To explore past experiences from conferences, to learn about memberships needs and wishes.
- To understand the nature of the relationship and collaboration with the local hosting NOGT, thus maintain consistency.
- To pay attention to other conference activities in the field, specifically EAGT ones.
- To support the local hosting NOGT in practical matter.
- To connect all the NOGTs in preparing the conference.
- To manage the know-how from organizing conferences.
- To take care of the continuity and development of the EAGT conferences.

We want to have a composition of a team with experience with organizing conferences, finances, communication skills, international cooperation, marketing skills, etc.

Requirements for EAGT committee members:

- It is expected that committee members stay for at least a period of 3 years, to give the committee continuity, but with a maximum of 9 years.



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- It is expected that committee members are active participants of the committee s/he is seated in and is familiar with working and communicating online.
- Committee members inform themselves by reading all EAGT information.
- Are actively involved in the committee projects.
- Are informed of developments in the field of Gestalt therapy and/or GPO (Gestalt Practitioner in Organizations) at national and international levels as well to content as to politics.
- Are the 'face' of our committee and EAGT
- Are full members of EAGT
- Master English to a degree that allows for fluent verbal and written communication.

We offer you:

- An opportunity to take part in embracing the conference and build a new manner of relating to it.
- An opportunity to address members wishes and needs.
- To rethink who we are in the new era EAGT steps into.
